Complete each of the following chords for SATB by adding the alto and tenor parts. Take care with range, doubling and spacing.




Exercise 1.4

Arrange each of the following triads for SATB by adding soprano, alto and tenor parts. Take care with range, doubling and spacing.




Complete each of the following for SATB by adding alto and tenor parts. The chord plan and roman numerals are included for you.








Complete each chord plan. Add the roman numerals and write parts for alto and tenor.






Complete each chord plan. Add roman numerals below the bass notes. It is good practice to choose the soprano part before adding alto and tenor parts.




Exercise 1.8

Complete each of the following for SATB by adding alto and tenor parts. The chord plan, roman numerals and solfa are included for you.







